
Q2 How many times can you say it, while you are playing Kabaddi? Is there any difference?

- (1) If he is stopped by the opposition.
- (2) He touches opposition players and could not stop him.
- (3) If he loses breath and cannot say Kabaddi-Kabaddi.

Q5 In some games it is very important to touch the player. For example in the game of Kho-Kho, you get 'out' when someone touches you. You also get your turn by someone's touch. Name some games in which it is very important to touch the players?
