He also brought Sanjivmi herbs to treat Lakshman. He remained of Ram.

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Q6 List some steps that can be taken to make buildings and monuments accessible to differently abled people.

Answer. The steps to be taken to make buildings and monuments accessible to differently abled people:

- (i) Construction of a ramp;
- (ii) Railing can be placed on the side walls of the staircase.
- (iii) The steps can be renovated so that people may not fall on the slippery ground.
